* Wilsden Community Library - Tuesdays (10:30am-5:30pm)

The library runs weekly on a Tuesday and is a fantastic facility which the village is lucky to have. There are a wide variety of books for adults, both fiction and non-fiction as well as a good selection of children's books for all ages, from babies to school age and young adults. There are also second hand books and jigsaws available to buy at low prices with all funds going towards the running of the library. It is free to become a member of Bradford Libraries and your membership card will give you access to all libraries within the Bradford district. If you would like any further details or would like a membership application form, please contact the village hall or pop along to have a chat with one of the friendly volunteers who help to run the library.



* Warm Space Scheme

This is an initiative to promote a network of Warm Spaces across Bradford District - places where anyone who is feeling the cold knows they can go to be warm. Bradford Council has worked alongside voluntary community and social enterprise organisations across the district to establish a network of warm spaces for residents this winter. These are heated spaces that anyone can access and spend time for free so they don't have to use their own utilities throughout the day. In our village, Wilsden Village Hall, Trinity Church, St Matthews Church and Wilsden Community Post Office have



all registered to be part of the Warm Space scheme. These will be available at different times throughout the week for people to go along to and have somewhere safe and warm to be.

From November, the village hall will be providing hot drinks, biscuits, newspapers, games, radio and access to the TV when we open the Youth Centre. Please see below for the opening times.


