This brand new group for pre-school children started in July!!

As well as our Toddlers Group on a Thursday morning, this additional stay, play and learn group will also provide a space for parents & carers and their children to come and meet others and have fun!

The group is held every Wednesday 9:15am-11:15am in our Lower Hall (term time only) and will offer a range of learning activities including crafts such as painting, gluing, making play dough and messy/sensory play. There are also a construction area, games, jigsaws, book area as well as an outdoor play area with pirate ship





and mud kitchen. Each session costs £3 per adult and one child (50p for additional children) and includes drinks for adults and drinks and snacks for the children.

#### \* Thursday Afternoon Group




This friendly social group had good cause for celebration earlier this year as it had it's 75th Anniversary from when it was established.

#### \* Wilsden Community Library



Our library which runs from the hall every Tuesday has so much to offer! With a large selection of children's books, a young reader's selection and a vast selection of fiction and nonfiction for adults. There are also adults and children's books and jigsaws for sale.

During the summer holidays, our volunteers will be running **Craft Sessions** for children at the library on a Tuesday between 11am-4pm (adult supervision required) and there is also the annual **Summer Reading Challenge** for children to encourage them to read as many books as they can during the break from school.

There will be very exciting visit from **Zoo Lab** who are coming to the library on Tuesday 8 August, 11am-12pm. This workshop will involve storytelling and the chance for children to meet some small animals and reptiles. Places can be reserved on a first come first served basis by putting your child's name down at the library. Please note that your child needs to have a library membership and also to have signed up for the Summer Reading Challenge to be eligible.

You can come along to Wilsden Community Library on a Tuesday (10:30am-5:30pm) to join for free if your child is not already a member of Bradford Libraries.


them for the positive impact they have on the community in Wilsden & Harecroft. These were:-

Lisa Firth received recognition for her volunteering work in various activities over the years. In 1996 she became a Brownie leader and volunteered at Laurel Bank care home whilst in sixth form. Lisa also lead on the revival of the Wilsden Gala through the formation of a committee in 2013. As a Trustee for the village hall she initiated the "40 Candles" campaign to raise much needed funds for the hall. Beyond Wilsden Lisa has also participated in running a summer scheme in Keighley for children with additional needs, has volunteered for Cubs and Rainbows organisations, was involved with the Bingley flood clear up in 2015 and has been an active member of the Harden Players Committee.



Astrid Hansen received her award for her contribution to the community for over 50 years. Astrid is a local historian and was part of the group who established the Wilsden Village Society in 1970 and was involved in the campaign to raise funds to build the village hall. She has written a number of books on local history, two of which have been about



Wilsden. One was a definitive history of the village while the other was a history of St Matthews church and it's various locations in the village. Astrid has also created a Wilsden Village Society website with a vast amount of local history and also regularly writes historical articles for the Parish Council magazine "The Wilsdener".

Local musician Colin Horsley played the keyboard and cleverly matched the tunes to the individuals who were coming up to the stage to receive their rewards which was greatly entertaining. Talented photographer Alan Manship captured some wonderful shots of everyone having fun the night.
